LODGING:

Free dormitory type of lodging will be provided to team members including one reserve and one manager from 21st to 28th February, 2010

ELIGIBILITY:

- a) Each affiliated Association/Institution member of AICF shall be entitled to send one team for each championship. Additional team shall be treated as special entry and shall pay the special entry fee.
- b) The host Haryana Chess Association is entitled to field one additional team in each Championship.
- c) Any club recommended by the respective AICF affiliated State Association can field a team for each championship by paying the special entry of Rs. 5,000/- per team.

OTHER RULES & REGULATIONS:

COMPOSITION OF THE TEAM:

Each team (Men & Women shall consist of four players one reserve player and one manager. The seeding of the teams will be done on the basis of average rating of the top 4 players. While sending entries, the names of all the players and their respective FIDE ratings, if any, should be given to enable the arbiters to arrive at the teams' average rating for ranking purposes. These names and ratings should be reconfirmed in person at the Technical Meeting.

REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS WITH AICF COMPULSORY:

All participants should get their names registered with AICF. Registration forms will be available at the venue on payment of Rs. 250/- for the year 2009-2010. No unregistered player will be allowed to participate in the tournament. If a player is already registered with AICF, he / she must show proof thereof.

ENTRIES & ENTRY FEES:

Normal Entry: Rs.3, 000/-

Special Entry: Rs.5, 000/-

The entry fee shall be paid by D.D. drawn in favor of **The Haryana Chess Association** payable at Gurgaon/ Delhi. Entries with payment should be sent to Mr. Pradeep Gupta, Organizing Secretary, C/o. Naresh Sharma, 305/12, Chandra Bhawan, Jacobpura, Gurgaon so as to be received on or before 02.02.2010. (Late entries will be received till 15.02.2010 with a late fee of Rs. 500/-)

SYSTEM OF PLAY:

The Tournament shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess.

SESSION OF PLAY & TIME CONTROL:

Team Swiss with a time control of 90 minutes each + 30 Secs increment per move from move No1.

CHESS CLOCKS:

Each team must provide at least two DGT chess clocks in working condition

TIE BREAKS:

Latest tie breaking rules will be applied.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

A tournament Committee consisting of Chief Arbiter, Hon Secretary of AICF or his representative, two members from different participating Associations and Secretary and two members of the Host Association shall be set up before commencement of the tournament.

APPEALS COMMITTEE:

Before the commencement of the Championship a five member committee of Appeal with two reserves shall also be formed from amongst the senior participants and officials present at the Technical meeting. All the five members and reserves will be from different states. No member of the committee shall vote on a dispute in which a player from as own unit is involved and in such cases the reserve members(s) shall take his/their places in the committee.

PROTESTS:

Protests, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing to the Chief Arbiter at least within 30 minutes of the of the incident with a protest fee of Rs. 500/- which shall be refunded if appeal is upheld.
