**Age Limit :** Players should be born on or after 01.01.1997

**Age Proof :** Each participant must produce a valid certificate to prove his/her age.

Certificates from School are not enough. Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality or Corporation obtained soon after birth. Players without date of birth certificates will not be allowed to participate.

**\*\*** The date of birth certificates registered within one year of the birth of the child alone will be recognized and allowed to participate. No state association shall recommend any player who doesn't come under the above criteria. Any player who is aggrieved by this stipulation can appeal to AICF with proper documentary proof and the AICF's decision in this regard will be FINAL and BINDING.

If any doubt arises about the claimed age of a player, the Tournament Committee has the right to refer the player during the championship for a due evaluation of age by competent medical experts. A player if declared over-age by such experts shall not continue in the championship and the matter shall be reported to AICF. Protest about the age of players may be made to the Chief Arbiter in writing along with a fee of Rs. 1000/- per player. This will not be refunded. Only the Coach or Manager deputed by participating State Chess Association can lodge such protests. The Tournament Committee has the right to decide the day, time and place for such medical evaluation of age. Players refusing to take the test as decided by the Tournament Committee shall be deemed to have failed the test and shall be disqualified from the Championship.

**Eligibility:** Subject to age limit following players can participate

- 1) In each category, two players from every affiliated State Association of AICF can take part. If any Association fails to send its quota, the vacancies so caused will not be filled.
- 2) Top four players from 2009 National under 13 (Boys & Girls) Chess Championships are eligible to participate as seeded players.
- 3) The top two players from 2009 National under 11 (Boys & Girls) Chess Championships are eligible to participate as seeded players in their respective categories.
- 4) The Champions in the last National Under-9 Chess Championship for Boys and Girls are eligible to take part in the respective categories.
- 5) 2009 World Championship top three rankers in any category subject to age stipulation.
- 6) 2009 Asian Under-12 top three rankers.
- 7) The AICF Secretary has a discretionary seat in each category in this Championship.
- 8) Any other player who remits the prescribed Special Entry Fee of Rs. 4,000/- (Subject to the approval from AICF)
- 9) The host Association is entitled to field one additional player in each category.
- 10) Current National Champion in any higher category subject to age stipulation.

- 11) Two players in each category from areas where no State Association exists. On application, such are selected by the Hon. Secretary, AICF.
- 12) The winner and runner up of 2009 National under-13 girls are eligible to play in boys section.
- 13) The Champion in 2009 National Under-11 Girls' category is eligible to play in Boys' category here.
- 14) If the number of participants at the start of the championship is an odd number in a category, the host association can add one entry to make it even.

**Entry Fee :** Ordinary Entry Rs. 700/- Special Entry Rs. 4,000/-.

There is a 50% concession in the entry fee for participants from North Eastern States, Andaman & Nicobar Islands. All entries including Special entries should come through the concerned State Association. The entry form should be sent together with the entry fee by a crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of **JCI Pondicherry Midtown** payable at **Pondicherry**.

**Late Fee :** Entries received after 15.06.2010 will be subject to a late fee of Rs. 250/- per player. However no entry will be entertained after 3 p.m. on 20.06.2010.

**Cash Prizes :** The Cash Prizes will be awarded to 15 players in each category amounting to Rs. 1,10,000/- in all as under.

**Tournament Committee :** A representative of the AICF, two members from different participating Associations and two members of the host Association will serve as the Tournament Committee.

**System of Play :** The Championship will be played under FIDE's Laws of Chess and the Swiss system. Totally eleven rounds shall be played unless otherwise decided by the Tournament Committee before the commencement of the championship.

**Session :** The rate of play shall be 90 minutes with an increment of 30 seconds per move from move number one. In the absence of digital clock the time control shall be 2 hours each straight finish. Changes in these timings or the number of rounds shall be announced by the Chief Arbiter at the start of the first rounds.

**Chess Clocks :** Each participating State Chess Association must provide at least one clock in working order for every two players entered into the Championship. As several problems arise all Stage Associations are urged to ensure that enough clocks are sent through their players.

**Tie Break :** Buchholz tie-break system will be applied.

**Zero Minute Rule :**

Zero Tolerance : The "zero tolerance" rules will be followed (i.e.); "Any player who arrives at the chessboard after the start of the session shall lose the game. Thus the default time is zero minutes".

**Protest :** Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.500/-within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

**Appeals Committee:** Before the commencement of the tournament, a five member Appeals Committee shall be formed by the AICF / organizers. All the members and Reserves shall be from the different States. No member of the Committee can vote on Dispute in which a player from his own state is involved and in such case(s), the reserves shall take his place in the committee.

**Disqualification :** No participant will leave the venue before the Prize Distribution function without the permission of the Chief Arbiter. The participants disregarding this rule will be suspended for one year.

**Interpretation :** For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without notice. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

**Registration of Players :** All participants in the National Championship should be registered with AICF for the year 2010-2011. Application forms are available at the website [www.indianchessfed.org](http://www.indianchessfed.org) Those who have already obtained registration cards from AICF Website for 2010-11 should send photo copy of the same. Those who have paid the AICF Registration fee but are yet to receive the AICF Registration card should send a photo copy acknowledgement for having paid the fee to organizers of earlier tournaments or to their association. Those who have not registered with AICF for the year 2010-2011 should send an amount of Rs. 250/- towards AICF registration fee along with the duly filled and signed AICF player's registration form plus one passport size photo.

**Arrears :** All arrears of affiliation fee/tournament fee including those of current year must be cleared by the Affiliated Association at the time of submitting the entries; otherwise the entries are liable to be rejected.

**Lodging :** Dormitory Lodging will be provided to players (normal entries only) and one accompanying official nominated by the concerned State Chess Association free of charge. All other accompanying persons should make their own arrangement for their stay.
